GENERAL WASTE COLLECTION REGULATIONS

RESIDENTS RESPONSIBILITY

The Municipality of Bethel Park provides weekly trash and garbage collection. Recycling takes place every other week on your regularly scheduled trash day. Waste Management, Inc. (WM) is the Municipality's waste collection and recycling service provider. **If your home is missed or you have a concern about service, please call the Municipality at 412-831-6800, extension # 130.** Be sure you have followed the guidelines listed in this newsletter before calling.

Place all containers at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your pickup day or can be placed curbside no earlier than 6:00 p.m. the day before to guarantee pickup. Empty containers must be removed from the curbside no later than 12:00 midnight on the day of collection. The contractor is not responsible to return for trash/recycling that has been set out late. Please separate trash and recycling, but not behind each other. The contractor is not responsible for the collection of any item outlined in this newsletter that is not properly prepared. Residents are responsible for clean-up of disturbed or scattered garbage/recycling.

Secure household garbage in containers up to 32 gallon that weigh no more than 50 lbs. Over-loading, loose garbage and bungee cords are a hazardous safety issue for the WM personnel and will not be picked up. Do not place garbage in boxes.

Effective January 1, 2013, in accordance with the "[Covered Device Recycling Act](#)", Act 108 of 2010, which requires the recycling of electronic devices, fluorescent and CLF bulbs; **please be advised that these items will no longer be permitted to be set out curbside.** Residents will have the option of taking advantage of e-cycling programs offered by numerous retail stores and other recycling organizations that collect electronic devices. These items will continue to be picked up in 2012.

ITEMS ACCEPTED WITH REGULAR TRASH COLLECTION FOR 2012

- **Appliances - the contractor will collect such items as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, and water coolers only** if the item has a sticker certifying that the refrigerant has been removed. Freezers and refrigerators must have doors removed. Items that do not have the sticker will not be picked up because it is unlawful for the contractor to dispose of anything containing refrigerant. You may call Appliance Warehouse at 1-888-GOFREON (1-888-463-7366), or a contractor of your choice, for Freon removal. Appliance Warehouse may collect items with Freon at certain times of the year.
- **Carpets** should be tied and bundled in lengths not to exceed 48 inches & 16 inches in diameter so that one man can lift. Padding must be tack-free and protected from the weather (otherwise will not be collected.)
- **Furniture, including mattresses and box springs, appliances, TV's up to 35", household goods and disassembled children's swing sets** will be accepted at curbside.
- **Hot Water Heaters** will be collected when placed curbside.
- **Light Bulbs, CFLs and Fluorescent Tubes** will be picked up curbside with regular trash. Must be double-bagged.
- **Bag your grass clippings and place them with your regular trash. Hedge cuttings, limbs and branches must** be securely tied and may not exceed 36 inches in length. No more than 8 bags of grass clippings, hedge cuttings, limbs and branches per week will be collected. Maximum weight is 25 pounds per bag or bundle.
- **Empty paint cans and/or dried paint may be placed** at curbside. Paint can be air-dried or soaked up with newspaper or kitty litter. The contractor will not accept paint cans with lids on.

ONLY ONE LARGE ITEM A WEEK CAN BE PLACED CURBSIDE FOR COLLECTION

Special Pick-up for large amounts of trash, call Waste Management, Inc. at 800-866-4460 or a hauler of your choice (Resident responsible for fee charged.)

RECYCLING AND LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM

Recycling takes place every other week on your regularly scheduled trash day. Please refer to the 2012 Municipal Waste Collection Schedule to determine your recycling weeks. Glass, cans & plastics may be co-mingled. Rinse out residue.

MATERIALS TO BE RECYCLED

Metal: Aluminum, steel, tin & bi-metal cans, aluminum foil & foil products.

Plastic: Items numbered 1-7. (Examples: Baby wipe containers, household cleaning products, margarine tubs, shampoo bottles & beverage bottles.)

Glass: Clear, brown, & amber glass containers.

Paper: Paperboard boxes (such as those used for cereal, tissues and shoes), copier paper, magazines, newspaper, catalogs, junk mail including envelopes and telephone books. Corrugated cardboard must be flattened, bundled and no larger than 14 x 14 inches.

You may NOT recycle: Styrofoam, fast food wrappers, food waste, paper towels, ceramics or bathroom trash.

You may call the Allegheny County Recycling Coordinator to obtain information on how to recycle items not collected by the Municipality. (412-578-8390 or www.achd.net - click the environmental tab.)

RECYCLING BINS

Recycling bins are the property of the Municipality for rental use and are to remain with the property when sold.

Residents with newly constructed homes can obtain a complimentary set of recycling bins at the Municipal Building.

Replacement bins are \$10.00 per bin. **Do NOT place items in plastic bags or boxes.**

HOW TO HANDLE LEAF WASTE

Full bags of leaf waste will be picked up on the same day as regular weekly trash for curbside collection during the listed leaf weeks only. Residents have the option of 1) composting the leaves in their own back yard, 2) mulching leaves with a mulching lawn mower 3) bagging leaves & putting them out for pick-up during the leaf collection weeks scheduled. 2012 MUNICIPAL WASTE SCHEDULE

Holiday Schedule:

Observed holidays in 2012 are Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. After a holiday falling on Monday through Friday, pickup for the rest of the week will be one day later than the usual day, which is extended to include Saturday. **If a holiday falls on the weekend, there will be no delay in trash/recycling pickup. There is no delay in trash/recycling pickup for the 2012 New Years Day holiday as it falls on a weekend.**

2012 Leaf Recycling Weeks:

May 14 - 18 October 22 – 26 October 29 – November 2 November 5 - 9 November 12 – 16
November 26 – 30 December 3 - 7

- One spring and six fall weeks of leaf collection are scheduled each year as indicated on the 2012 Municipal Waste Collection Schedule as shown on the left.
- There is no leaf recycling pick-up Thanksgiving week.
- Leaves must be placed in brown paper leaf bags available in local stores or in containers or boxes clearly marked "LEAVES" that can be easily dumped. **The use of plastic bags as a receptacle for leaves is prohibited and will not be collected.**

Below is the 2012 Municipal Garbage & Recycling schedule. Recycling is picked up every other week on your regular trash day. Check the table below to see if your street or townhouse complex is in Week A or Week B and then look at the calendar on the left to see which weeks you will receive recycling pick-up.

COMMERCIAL, INSTITUTIONAL AND MULTI-FAMILY RECYCLING REQUIREMENT NOTICE

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 150 (c) of the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act (Act 101), the Municipality of Bethel Park has adopted an Ordinance requiring all commercial and institutional establishments in the Municipality to implement recycling programs. All multi-family residences not covered under the Municipal waste contract are also required to implement a recycling program.

The Municipality's Ordinance requires that all commercial and institutional establishments and all multi-family residences not covered under the Municipal waste contract develop a system for recycling at a minimum the following items:

- High grade office paper
- Aluminum
- Corrugated paper
- Leaf waste

All establishments are required to submit the amount recycled in 2011 to the Municipality by January 31, 2012. A copy of an example reporting form may be found on the Municipality's web page - www.bethelpark.net.
